



Village Age Distribution




Area C Age Distribution

Community Profile

- 0 – 4 age group is very large, especially in the Village of Pemberton
- Largest population mix is 30-49 yrs
- Single detached homes comprise 1/3 of the Village – most in surrounding Electoral Area C
- 50% of the Village population lives in multi-family homes
- Singles in the Village = approx. 145, including surrounding Area C
- 105 lone parent families
- Average Household of 2.75 people per home
- Low income families below provincial average
- Village of Pemberton has experienced high rates of population growth
- Surrounding Area C population has reduced a little
- Village of Pemberton has estimated moderate growth rate of 4.7% for the next 20 years ♣
- Small senior/retirement population
- Village of Pemberton is planning a Boundary extension
- Electoral Area C - 5,600 square kilometers in size
- Electoral Area C is home to long-time residents with agricultural roots, young families new to the area, part-time residents, and the growing Lil'wat and N'Quatqua First Nations.
- Electoral Area C offers a diverse economy - focus on agriculture, tourism and forestry, but also supports a number of home-based businesses.

Pemberton Overview

Pemberton and its surrounding area is a fast-growing community with many young families. It is also home to many people involved with the ski industry, that enjoy the whistler mountains and love an active outdoor adventure lifestyle in the mountainous area of the Pemberton Valley.

The town has a good variety of very cozy eating places and coffee shops. We have 3 gas stations and even a McDonald's.

Pemberton has its origin as a logging and farming community. Today many people live in Pemberton and work in Whistler, which is a scenic 25-minute drive to the south on Hwy 99. The towns demographic has changed in recent years. There is a large growth in the number of young families and millennials – this is a trend that we expect to see continue, and also represents a huge mission field that PCC is very keen to reach.
