**Text: James 3:13-16**

**I. THE \_\_\_\_\_ FOR WORTHWHILE WISDOM(v.13)**

- “Wise” described the individual who possessed \_\_\_\_\_ insight and skill in deciding matters of conduct.
- “Understanding”-the knowledge of an \_\_\_\_\_.

**II. THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF WORLDLY WISDOM (v.14)**
