Call to Worship – Read Aloud

“For a day in your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of wickedness. For the Lord God is a sun and a shield; the Lord bestows favor and honor. No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly. O Lord of hosts, blessed is the one who trusts in You.” Psalm 84:10-12

Prayer (about 10 minutes) – spend a few minutes in prayer together.

- Pray also for our government officials: Earl Funk and town council; Kelvin Goertzen and provincial government; and Ted Falk and Justin Trudeau with the federal government.
- Pray for our church as well, that we would grow in love for one another, that we would find ways to connect with each other, and that we would pray specifically for each other.
- And let us not forget to be thankful and offer praises to God! We’re thankful for His grace upon us and His everlasting kindness to His people. May we continually come before Him full of praise and thanksgiving!
- Pray for many to come to a saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ during this time through the faithful witness of God’s people.
- Pray that we would be fed by the word this morning!

Discussion - Use these questions for personal reflection and family conversation/teaching after the sermon. You can use them right away, over lunch, over supper, or even throughout the week. Working through them will give you some things to focus on for the week, both for yourself and others. It is our prayer that they be of benefit for you as you come together in your homes to worship God.

- Read Galatians 5:19-23 What kinds of blessing should we be looking for? What does a good harvest look like? Think of specific areas in your life where the fruit of the Spirit would be a blessing (i.e. self control in an area of strong temptation, patience in a time of testing, etc.)
- What kinds of things should you be planting? Give thought to your life this week and pray for wisdom in what areas you need to grow. James 1:5-6
- Are there areas you have been planting sin in your life? Bitterness, resentment, unbelief, greed, lust, etc. Take time to consider these things and to repent of them. James 1:21
