**Luke 16:1-14**

1. As you read through this story that Jesus told people - do you think it is a parable, or a story from their own experience (that Jesus had heard of in their town)?
2. What do you think is the main point?
3. Do you think this is about money, or about more than money?
4. How does an understanding of the broader context of the story (what comes in Luke 14&15, and the story of Lazarus in Luke 16) help us to understand what is going on in this account?
5. If Jesus were telling you this story, how would he adjust it to fit your current situation - in order to challenge you on the "you cannot serve two masters" statement?
6. When you consider that fact that God is willing to entrust you with more, what are the kinds of things that come to mind for you? What kind of spiritually life-fulfilling investments could you do that would excite and energize you?
