

Celebrant As we prepare to meet the risen Christ at the table, let us confess to God our brokenness and our need.

Give us life, O God, to enable us to change ourselves and the world, that we may walk in your way and glory in your name. Amen.**

Celebrant It is indeed right to give you thanks most loving God, through Jesus, our Redeemer, the first born from the dead, the pioneer of our salvation, who is with us always, one of us, yet from the heart of God. For with your whole created universe, we praise you for your unfailing gift of life. We thank you that you have created us and stay with us even when we turn from you.

All glory to you Giver of Life sufficient for all creation, accept our praises, living God for Jesus Christ, the one perfect offering for the world, who on the night he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, broke it, gave it to his disciples and said, "Take, eat, this is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

After supper he took the cup and when he had given thanks he gave it to them and said, "Drink this, all of you, this is my blood of the new covenant which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sin. Do this as often as you drink it in remembrance of me."

Therefore God of creation, in the suffering and death of Jesus, our Redeemer, we meet you in glory. Empower our celebration with your Holy Spirit, feed us with your life, fire us with your love, and confront us with your justice.

Because you are one of us, O Christ, enable us to share your life with the world by sharing our own lives with the world. And so we pray in the words you have taught us as we sing:

Lord's Prayer

All Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Save us from the time of trial, and deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and for ever. Amen.

Celebrant We break this bread of life recalling the body of Christ broken for us. We lift up the cup of salvation and call upon your name.

All Here and now, with this bread and wine, we celebrate your great acts of liberation and love.

Celebrant The Gifts of God for the people of God.

All **Thanks be to God.**
