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## INTRODUCTION

CALVARY GROWTH TRACK is designed to help you discover your purpose and become a fully-devoted follower of Jesus Christ. From growing as a believer in Jesus, exploring the mission of Calvary Church, connecting with the people and finding a fulfilling place to use your talents through volunteer service on TeamCalvary, we will provide you with a path to experience growth and fulfillment.

In a natural progression of a person's faith journey, they discover Jesus and decide to follow Him. Learning the Bible, prayer, connecting with other believers in a local church comes next. An invitation to follow Jesus is common at Calvary. The next steps of growing in faith is what CALVARY GROWTH TRACK is all about. Essentials 101 - Learn some basic steps and tools so that you can continue growing spiritually. Church 201 - Find out why Calvary is such a great place for you and your family to put down roots and grow deeper. Connecting 301 - Connect with a smaller group of people so that you are walking down the faith road with others. TeamCalvary 401 - Use your gifts and and serve on volunteer teams giving back to community.

Growth Track is comprised of four specifically designed classes listed below. Each one helps you take a step towards Jesus and God's plan of fulfillment for your life. Ultimately, our goal is for you to encounter Christ and to help you connect with a group of people where your life can touch the lives of others. Each class runs for 60 minutes at 9am in the Fireside Room (Rm124 across from the Nursery on the lower level).

### **ESSENTIALS 101** (First Sunday of month)

This class will help guide you through the essential steps that every believer needs to take to become fully devoted followers of Christ. Topics include: prayer, reading & studying the Bible, giving and water baptism.

### **CHURCH 201** (Second Sunday of month)

This class will give you a basic introduction to the mission, vision, and story values of Calvary Church. You'll also learn about church membership.

### **CONNECTING 301** (Third Sunday of month)

This class is your opportunity to get connected to a small group. Sharing life with others is a big part of your journey. Even Jesus had the 12 disciples. You'll also learn more about our church web portal called CALVARYCONNECT.

### **TEAMCALVARY 401** (Fourth Sunday of month)

This class will help you discover more about serving and volunteer opportunities, growth, and the fulfillment that comes from being on TeamCalvary. Learn about some specialized ministry groups and activate your God-given giftings to become the minister you were created to be.

## **ESSENTIALS 101** - Vital components to your faith journey

### **OUR HOPE FOR YOU**

Today at CALVARY GROWTH TRACK 101 our hope is to help you learn and put into practice what we believe are four essential habits of every follower of Jesus. It is through these habits that we develop a deeper relationship with Christ. By learning how the Bible is alive and that Jesus speaks to us today, how to fellowship with other believers, by living a Spirit led life, and by giving of ourselves we will deepen our faith.

*“So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in Him, rooted and built up in Him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.”* **Colossians 2:6-7**

### **UNDERSTANDING BIBLICAL CHRISTIANITY**

We'll take time to look at each of these habits, so make sure to jot your questions down for a Q&A after the teaching time. *“And for an entire year they met with the church and taught considerable numbers; and the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.”* **Acts 11:26** (NASB) Before followers of Jesus were called “Christians”, they were known as disciples. As disciples, we develop a deep relationship with Christ through:

- **Bible study and prayer**

*“They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching ... and to prayer.”* **Acts 2:42**

- **Fellowship with other believers**

*“They devoted themselves to...fellowship.”* **Acts 2:42**

- **Living a Spirit-led life**

*“Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the Apostles.”*  
**Acts 2:43**

- **Giving of ourselves**

*“They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need”* **Acts 2:45**

## HABIT ONE: BIBLE STUDY & PRAYER

*"The whole Bible was given to us by inspiration from God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives; it straightens us out and helps us do what is right. It is God's way of making us well prepared at every point, fully equipped to do good to everyone."* **2 Timothy 3:16-17** (LB)

## TALKING WITH GOD

*"Always be joyful. Never stop praying."* **1 Thessalonians 5:16-17**(NLT)

Jesus exemplified a personal relationship with God through prayer that gave Him great strength. Every person who has ever been effective in service for God has developed this habit. The only way to be a healthy Christian is to spend time with God daily through prayer.

And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one, for yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever.”*





## HABIT TWO: FELLOWSHIP WITH OTHER BELIEVERS

*“Let us not give up the habit of meeting together, as some are doing. Instead, let us encourage one another.”* **Hebrews 10:25** (GN)

God never intended for us to go through life alone. Throughout the Bible, we see the importance of being in community. In fact, authentic life-change happens in the context of relationships.

At Calvary Church, we believe our church must grow LARGER and SMALLER at the same time. LARGER because new people are making decisions to follow Jesus, and SMALLER via small groups so that you can personally connect with people in faith, not just in the large group Sunday Worship experience, but throughout the week.

*“They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.”* **Acts 2:46-47**

*“They met day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house.”* **Acts 5:42**

*“You know that I have not hesitated to preach anything that would be helpful to you but have taught you publicly and from house to house.”* **Acts 20:20**

How can the church grow larger yet maintain close relationships? Its all about being a part of a smaller grouping. Every member needs to be a part of a small group of some sort.

CALVARY GROWTH TRACK 301- discusses this in depth, but here are some highlights. Every encouragement will come to you to be in a small group. There are three main types of small groups. Home Groups, Service Groups and Special Interest groups. Pastoral Care, prayer, and ongoing support will come from the small group. **When we talk about 'the church', it is always about the people.** Everyone leads busy, full lives, and in order to get the best experience out of Calvary, time should be set aside for a small group.

### **HABIT THREE: LIVING A SPIRIT-LED LIFE**

*"May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."* **2 Corinthians 13:14**

Having close relationships with other people is only part of God's plan for our lives. He desires to be our most intimate friend.

### **WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?**

There are some fantastic Greek and Hebrew words used in the original languages of the scripture to describe the Holy Spirit.

**Ruwach** – a wind, breath, a violent exhalation, blast of breath.

*"Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters."* **Genesis 1:2**

**Pneuma** – a current of air, blast of breath, a strong breeze.

*"The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you are spirit and they are life."* **John 6:63** (NIV 1984)

**1. The Holy Spirit is a \_\_\_\_\_ .**

*"I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever."* **John 14:16** (NASB)

## THE HOLY SPIRIT'S ROLE IN OUR LIVES

*"Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Which," He said, "you heard of from Me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now...you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.""* **Acts 1:4-8** (NASB)

### 1. The Holy Spirit enables us to know God's:

And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment."* **John 16:5-8** (NASB)

*"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control."* **Galatians 5:22-23** (NASB)

To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he gives them to each one, just as he determines.”* **1 Corinthians 12:4-11**

*“In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. I will show wonders in the heaven above and signs on the earth. For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.”* **John 3:16**

The Gospel is the ultimate demonstration of God’s generous nature towards mankind. The Bible consistently teaches that God blesses us so that we may bless others.

## **HOW DO I LIVE A SPIRIT-LED LIFE?**

### **1. Remove all \_\_\_\_\_ to hearing from the Lord**

*“Peter replied, ‘Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.’”* **Acts 2:38**

### **2. Request the \_\_\_\_\_ .**

*“Now suppose one of your fathers is asked by his son for a fish; he will not give him a snake instead of a fish, will he? Or if he is asked for an egg, he will not give him a scorpion, will he? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?”* **Luke 11:11-13** (NASB)

### **3. Receive Him \_\_\_\_\_ .**

*“Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God’s grace in its various forms.”* **Peter 4:10**

### **4. Relate to Him \_\_\_\_\_ .**

*“The amazing grace of the Master, Jesus Christ, the extravagant love of God, the intimate friendship of the Holy Spirit, be with all of you.”* **2 Corinthians 13:14** (Message)

5. Release your \_\_\_\_\_ with confidence.

*"Since you are eager to have spiritual gifts, try to excel in gifts that build up the church."*  
**1 Corinthians 14:12**

## HABIT FOUR: GIVING OF OURSELVES

*"Give happily to those in need, and always be ready to share whatever God has given you. By doing this, you will be storing up real treasure for yourselves in heaven - it is the only safe investment for eternity!"* **1 Timothy 6:18-19** (LB)

## AREAS OF GIVING

## WHAT ABOUT WATER COMMUNION AND BAPTISM?

### THE MEANING OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

Jesus never asked His disciples to remember His birth. But He did instruct them to remember His death and resurrection. He gave the church two visible symbols (called "ordinances") as reminders of His death. These two ordinances are: Baptism and The Lord's Supper. The Lord's Supper is an object lesson that represents a great spiritual truth for believers.

#### I. WHAT IS THE LORD'S SUPPER? (1 Corinthians 11:23-26)

1. IT IS A \_\_\_\_\_.

"The Lord Jesus, on the night He was betrayed, took bread." (vs. 23)

2. IT IS A \_\_\_\_\_.

"...and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, 'This is my body, which is for you; eat it in remembrance of me.'" (vs. 24)

3. IT IS A \_\_\_\_\_.

"In the same way, He took the cup, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood; drink it to remember me.'" (vs. 25)

4. IT IS A \_\_\_\_\_.

"For whenever you eat the bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes back." (vs. 26)

#### II. WHO SHOULD TAKE THE LORD'S SUPPER?

Only those who are already BELIEVERS. (Mark 14:22-26)

"For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment upon himself." **2 Corinthians 11:29**

#### III. HOW DO I PREPARE MYSELF FOR THE LORD'S SUPPER?

"Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. A person ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup." **1 Cor. 11:27-28** (NIV)

1. Self-Examination - **1 Corinthians 11:27**
2. Confessing My Sins - **1 John 1:9**
3. Recommitment - **Romans 12:1**
4. Restoring Relationships - **Matthew 5:23-24**

## IV. WHEN AND HOW OFTEN SHOULD WE OBSERVE THE LORD'S SUPPER?

Jesus never said when or how often believers should observe The Lord's Supper. At Calvary we celebrate Communion on the 1st Sunday of each month, during the morning services.

## THE MEANING OF BAPTISM

Are you taking this class for baptism? The Baptism Form can be found on Appendix 5 (page 58).

### I. WHY SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

1. TO FOLLOW THE EXAMPLE SET BY \_\_\_\_\_ .

*"One day Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee, and John baptized him in the Jordan River."* **Mark 1:9** (NLT)

2. BECAUSE CHRIST \_\_\_\_\_ IT.

*"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*  
**Matthew 28:19-20** (NIV)

3. IT DEMONSTRATES THE DEPTH OF OUR \_\_\_\_\_ .

*"...many of the people who heard Him believed and were baptized."* **Acts 18:8** (Ph)

*"We know that we have come to know Him, if we obey His commands."* **1 John 2:3** (NIV)

### II. WHAT IS THE MEANING OF BAPTISM?

1. IT ILLUSTRATES CHRIST'S \_\_\_\_\_ AND RESURRECTION.

*“Christ died for our sins... He was buried...and He rose again.” 1 Cor 15:3-4 (Ph)*

*“Having been buried with him in baptism and raised with him through your faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead.” Col. 2:12 (NIV)*

## 2. IT ILLUSTRATES MY \_\_\_\_\_ AS A CHRISTIAN.

*“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!” 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV)*

*“We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.” Romans 6:4 (NIV)*

Baptism doesn't make you a believer — it shows that you already believe. Baptism does not “save” you, only your faith in Christ does that. Baptism is like a wedding ring — it's the outward symbol of the commitment made in your heart.

*“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith...it is the gift of God —not by works, so that no one can boast.” Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV)*

### III. WHY BE BAPTIZED BY IMMERSION?

#### BECAUSE \_\_\_\_\_ WAS BAPTIZED THAT WAY.

*“As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water.” Matthew 3:16 (NIV)*

#### EVERY BAPTISM IN THE \_\_\_\_\_ WAS BY IMMERSION.

*(Example) “...then both Philip and the man went down into the water and Philip baptized him. When they came up out of the water...” Acts 8:38-39*

#### THE WORD “BAPTIZE” MEANS TO \_\_\_\_\_ WATER.”

The Greek word baptizo means, “to immerse or dip under water.”

#### IT BEST SYMBOLIZES A BURIAL AND RESURRECTION!

The founders of denominations agree:

- Martin Luther...“I would have those who are baptized to be entirely immersed, as the word imports & the mystery signifies.”
- John Calvin...“The word ‘baptize’ signifies to immerse. It is certain that immersion was the practice of the ancient church.”
- John Wesley...“Buried with Him, alludes to baptizing by immersion according to the custom of the first church.”

## IV. WHO SHOULD BE BAPTIZED?

**EVERY PERSON WHO HAS \_\_\_\_\_ IN CHRIST.**

*“Those who believed and accepted His message were baptized.” **Acts 2:41** (Ph)*

*“Simon himself believed and was baptized..” **Acts 8:13** (NIV)*

*“But when they believed Philip as he preached the Good News...and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.” **Acts 8:12** (NIV)*

## BABY DEDICATIONS

At Calvary, we wait until children are old enough to believe and understand the true meaning of baptism before we baptize them. We practice a ‘Child Dedication’ for babies and young children. This ceremony is intended to be a covenant between the parents or guardians and God on the behalf of the child. The parents promise to raise their child in the faith until the child is old enough to make his/ her own personal confession of Christ.

We also pray a prayer of blessing over the child, and as a church family commit to stand and believe for the child to grow with a knowledge of who Jesus Christ is and a clear understanding of His purpose for their lives. This custom began about 300 years after the Bible was completed. This is different from the baptism talked about in the Bible, which was only for those old enough to believe. The purpose is to publicly confess your personal commitment to Christ.

## V. WHEN SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

**AS SOON AS YOU HAVE BELIEVED!**

**“Those who believed...were baptized...that day!” **Acts 2:41** (Ph)**

*“Then Philip began with the scripture and told him the Good News about Jesus. As they traveled along the road, they came to some water, and the man said, ‘Look, here is water! Why shouldn’t I be baptized right now?’ Philip said, ‘If you believe with all your heart, you may.’ The man answered, ‘I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.’ So they went down into the water and Philip baptized him.” **Acts 8:35-38** (Ph)*

There is no reason to delay. As soon as you have decided to receive Christ into your life, you can and should be baptized. If you wait until you are “perfect”, you’ll never feel “good enough!”

## CAN MY FAMILY BE BAPTIZED TOGETHER?

Yes! If each family member understands fully the meaning of baptism, and each one has personally placed his/her trust in Christ for salvation, we encourage families to be baptized at the same time. It is a wonderful expression of commitment. However, it is important to remember that baptism is a personal statement of faith, not a family tradition. It is usually

not wise to delay your baptism while waiting on other family members to accept Christ, particularly children. This puts an undue pressure on them, and delays your obedience.

### **WILL I HAVE TO SAY ANYTHING?**

YES! But don't worry, it not will not be at the live event. Testimonies are pre filmed in the weeks leading up to your baptism. That way our media team can make sure that all the Sunday time considerations are honored, and you say what you mean to say for your public declaration of faith. Sometimes having the lights shine at you and hundreds of people watching can rattle even the strongest of nerves. At the beginning of the service, the Pastor will briefly explain the meaning of baptism. Your prepared video will be shown, and you will be baptised by the pastor, elder, or small group leader. You will be mailed or presented with a certificate the following Sunday. We encourage you to invite all your relatives and friends to attend your baptism. The Lord has done great things!

### **NEXT STEPS**

1. Commit to daily spiritual growth of reading your Bible, prayer, fellowship, living a spirit led life and giving generously of yourself.

## **CHURCH 201 - We Are Calvary**

### **OUR HOPE FOR YOU**

Today at CALVARY GROWTH TRACK 201, our hope is to give you a basic introduction to our church family. Since we have members from many different backgrounds, this class is designed to clearly explain who we are and what we believe. Whether you are new to your walk with Jesus, or have been following Him for decades is not important. Every church has a different flavour and history, and we're glad you've chosen to find out more about Calvary's journey.

### **What is "The Church?"**

That is a layered question that can get muddled up because of language. I go to a church, we meet at a church, we are the church and Calvary is a church are all accurate statements. It is an interesting question because of these variety of responses.

The answer that we focus on at Calvary is, we are the church. I am the church. That idea is very transformational in a person's life. It conveys that you are an active, world changing agent, not passively waiting for something to happen for you. Jesus said in **Matthew 16:18** (MSG)

*"God bless you, Simon, son of Jonah! You didn't get that answer out of books or from teachers. My Father in heaven, God himself, let you in on this secret of who I really am. And now I'm going to tell you who you are, really are. You are Peter, a rock. This is the rock on which I will put together my church, a church so expansive with energy that not even the gates of hell will be able to keep it out."*

From this beginning declaration of Jesus, followed up by the book of ACTS, we see a church of mission and passion pro-actively engaging in the work of the kingdom. We are the church, and the church is always about people. This missional view of what the church is chases away incorrect perceptions of what the church is not. Sometimes the church is viewed as a magical building where magical things happen if you wish it into being.

'I wish the church would do more for the homeless.' 'I wish the church could call the shut-ins and arrange a visit.' 'I wish the church would arrange an outreach program for the local school.'

There is no 'the church' except the people of the church. If YOU are the church, the answer to all these things seems clearer. There is no group of people waiting beside a big red phone, eager to engage in what the Lord is talking to YOU about. If you are the church, what are you doing to make it happen? You are the church! Let's get out there and BE the church. A building does not make a church, an incorporated name does not make a church. If we were hiding underground in Albania we would still be the church, and that is exciting!

Over the next segments of Growth Track, we will talk about Calvary in particular and how we here carry out the function of the church. In addition, Growth Tracks weeks 3 and 4, we discuss connecting to the people and using your giftings to bless others.

## What Calvary Is

There are many great churches where Jesus is doing great things. You may be new to faith and church life or have previously attended somewhere else where things are done a little differently. This class will help bring clarity and unity to WHAT CALVARY IS. Feel free to store up your questions for Q&A at the ends of each class.

*"I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought."* **1 Corinthians 1:10** (NIV)

Being at Calvary does not mean we all agree on every last point. There are diverse views on some subjects, but there is only one good news of Jesus Christ, the son of God, who died for our sins that we might connect with our Father in Heaven.

At Calvary, we have an expressive worship experience, where you are encouraged to sing BIG to our God, clap hands and raise up hands as a sign of surrendering our lives to Jesus. We use contemporary media to illustrate the messages, and encourage generosity in tithes and offerings during service times. We offer premium children and youth programs where kids will be taught about Jesus and the Bible. We are active in international missions and serve our local community. We practice an open communion and baptize by full immersion. Church community happens through small groups and all of this is about Jesus.

## OUR VISION (Mission vs. Vision)

It's important to also understand the difference between mission and vision.

**Mission:** Our mission is unchanging. It is set by Jesus Himself in the Great Commandment and the Great Commission. "To love God and love people while leading them to become fully devoted followers of Christ."

**Vision:** Our vision on the other hand is contextual. It's how we fulfill our mission in our culture and community in the time we're living in and what we see and believe for the future.

## **OUR STORY**

### **Who We Are**

Calvary Church began its ministry in May 1994 after the merge of two well-established churches, Surrey Christian Fellowship and Calvary Community Church. Pastor Gordon McDonald and Pastor Harvey Schroeder joined together to provide spiritual leadership for

their growing congregations. To respond to the rapid growth in the Fraser Heights community, the church expanded also. On October 12, 1997, the congregation held their first service in their new auditorium.

As the diversity of the community continued to increase, a small group was started in September 2001 to minister to the needs of the Mandarin speaking families that began attending Calvary. As this group continued to grow and the burden for the Chinese community intensified, the Mandarin campus of Calvary was born in May of 2003. What started as a small group Bible study has now grown significantly to a thriving and active ministry to the Chinese community of the Lower Mainland that now meets together for Calvary's weekly Mandarin service, as well as ongoing activities and classes throughout the week.

Pastor Gordon and his wife Glenda faithfully served and led the church for 40 years. On June 22nd, 2014 he retired as the senior pastor and in recognition of his years of exemplary service to Calvary he was given the honorary title of Pastor Emeritus. At our Annual General Meeting on June 8th, 2014 Pastor Steven MacDonald was unanimously elected as the new Senior Pastor of Calvary Church after more than 9 years of committed pastoral service and leadership here at the church. He was later installed as Senior Pastor on Sunday, June 22nd, 2014 and the shepherd's staff was passed from Pastor Gordon to Pastor Steven.

Pastor Steven and his wife Susan see a church that is a centre of hope ministering the Good News to our city in a creative, caring and credible way. Today under Pastor Steven's leadership, serving alongside a gifted and passionate pastoral team, an amazing staff, and the most committed volunteer team on the planet; our future is bright and exciting. New families and individuals are continually becoming a part of our mission to love God and love people while leading them to become fully devoted followers of Christ. With five worship experiences each weekend at 9AM, 10:30AM, 12PM and 9AM & 10:30AM in Mandarin, we continue to grow and multiply as the vision moves forward and more than 1600 people call Calvary their home.





## SALVATION

We consider reaching people with the love of Jesus to be one of our greatest responsibilities. Salvation is believing in your heart that Jesus is Lord and that God raised him from the dead. He did these things so our lives could move from spiritual darkness to light. Our weekend services serve people at all stages in their spiritual journey and are easily accessible to the unchurched as well as those who believe in Jesus.

## PEOPLE STARTING ON THEIR FAITH JOURNEY

Everyone is at a different point in their Christian walk. Some have been walking with Jesus for decades, others are new to hearing the good news that Jesus brings, and still others haven't experienced the love and life that Jesus offers. Every one of us can do our part to encourage others along by following these four principles:

1. **Accept the personal Responsibility to help each person regardless of where they are at in their journey.**
2. **Build a personal Relationship with a person regardless of where they are at in their journey**
3. **Share your personal Story with everyone**
4. **Give a personal Invitation to experience Jesus at a weekend service or small group.**

## **REACHING OUT** (Local, Regional, and International Outreach)

Jesus gave His Church the job to reach out to the world around them in three areas:

*"You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."* **Acts 1:8**

### 1. "In Jerusalem" - \_\_\_\_\_ - **Surrey.**

*"Real religion, the kind that passes muster before God the Father, is this: Reach out to the homeless and loveless in their plight."* **James 1:27** (Message)

The primary way we reach our city is through our support of NightShift ministries, the local schools, and the consistent witness of the congregation in our homes, neighbourhoods and workplaces.

### 2. "In Judea and Samaria" - \_\_\_\_\_ - **the Lower Mainland GVRD.**

*"Whatever a person is like, I try to find common ground with him so that he will let me tell him about Christ and let Christ save him."* **1 Corinthians 9:22** (LB)

The primary way we reach the lower mainland is through our small groups and individual outreach efforts. Our small groups span from Coquitlam through Langley and are run by Calvary members.

### 3. "To the ends of the Earth" - \_\_\_\_\_.

The primary way we do this is through international missions. Both student and adult missions teams are sent from Calvary to assist with building project and to minister to the needs of people. Our mission work includes church plant in Turkey, and Ukraine and our ongoing ministry in Haiti. Every second year, we send a team to serve and minister in these parts of the world. Based on the need and the skills of the team we do building projects, kids programs, and medical clinics. Our secondary international missions have included family ministry trips in the Dominican Republic and Mexico.

The Canadian network of churches that we belong to is the Pentecostal Holiness Church of Canada ([www.phcc.ca](http://www.phcc.ca)) run internationally through the International Pentecostal Holiness Church ([www.iphc.org](http://www.iphc.org)). We partner and support these established and thriving ministries to provide a purposeful, consistent and safe way to do what we can on the world scene. We are better together.

## **WHAT CAN I DO?**

The most valuable way you can participate in reaching out is to engage in all three of these.

But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." **Matthew 6:19-21** (NIV 1984)

## **CHURCH LEADERSHIP**

Believers who invest their hearts, time, families, and finances in the building of a local church deserve to have confidence in church leadership. People are looking for leaders who conduct themselves with integrity and respect when making decisions that affect their families.

Our church government is made up of the Lead Pastor, Pastor's Executive Team, the Church Board, and our Small Group Leadership:

### **1. GUIDED BY \_\_\_\_\_.**

The Executive Team is led by the lead pastor, Steve MacDonald. His team oversees the day-to-day ministry and operations of the church. Pastors on this team serve the congregation and are responsible for the development of the spiritual life of the church. The lead pastor is hired by the church board, and the lead pastor hires the pastoral staff and support staff to serve with him.

### **2. PROTECTED BY THE \_\_\_\_\_.**

The church board is made up of 8 elected members of the congregation and led by the lead pastor as Chairman of the Board. They serve on rotating 3 year terms. The church board hires the lead pastor and gives 8 elected directors oversight and direction to the business of the church. It has internal committees for special projects, benevolence, building maintenance and improvement. All Calvary members in good standing are eligible to be recommended for the board. Written nomination to apply for these posts need to be submitted to the lead pastor 2 weeks before the Annual General Meeting held each spring.

### 3. STRENGTHENED BY \_\_\_\_\_.

Small group leadership takes on many forms, from leading home groups, special interest groups and service groups. Leading our FIT teams, BIGtime Kids/Route Youth and home group ministries are highly valued examples of small group leadership. Calvary operates because of the commitment and care of these leaders and the value they place on seeing the congregation grow to become fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ.

#### **MEMBERSHIP at Calvary Church**

New Members are publicly recognized and prayed for at the church during our Sunday Service on the same day as our AGM. **You can submit your member application ANYTIME throughout the year.** Give it to your Growth Track teacher or at the Welcome Centre. It will be reviewed by our senior leadership and you can expect a confirmation call or email within 2 weeks. After that verification step you are considered a member of the church. (Members stand and unite with the congregation in prayer as a public declaration of their intent.)

As a member, you represent Calvary Church in our congregation and to the community. Members need to have received Jesus as their Lord and Savior and be in agreement with the values and ideas presented in this Growth Track 101 class. Becoming a member is indicative of your intent to lay down long roots in the church, protecting the unity of the church, acting in love towards other members, refusing to gossip and by following the church's leadership. Becoming a member indicates your desire to share in the responsibility of praying for the church and your personal growth, inviting the unchurched to hear about Jesus' love and warmly welcoming those regardless of where they are in their faith journey. Membership also indicates your desire to serve in the church's ministries by discovering your talents, being equipped by the pastors and developing your servant's heart. Becoming a member indicates your intent to develop your spiritual life and those of others by faithfully engaging in small groups, living a godly life and regular financial giving.

We understand this based on the scriptures in APPENDIX 3.

9. Every Christian can be baptized in the Holy Spirit. This is an act of faith on the part of the believer. The initial evidence of the reception of this experience is speaking with other tongues as the Spirit leads. (**Luke 11:13; Acts 1:5; Acts 2:1-4; Acts 8:17; Acts 10:44-46; Acts 19:6**)

10. God has the power to heal and does heal today in answer to prayer. (**Isaiah 53:4, 5; Matthew 8:16, 17; Mark 16:14-18; Exodus 15:26**)

11. Jesus will return to earth again soon to establish His Kingdom.

12. It is the responsibility of every believer to dedicate his or her life to sharing the gospel message. (**Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-20; Acts 1:8**)

13. Christ modeled and established water baptism by immersion (**Acts 19:5; 10:47, 48; 8:37, 38**) and the Lord's Supper for His followers. (**I Corinthians 11:23-32**)

## CONNECTED 301 - SMALL GROUPS

### OUR HOPE FOR YOU

Today at CALVARY GROWTH TRACK 301, our hope is that you will discover the importance of small groups in the church, our philosophy as to what small groups are, how to create, lead and attend a small group. You will learn about our church's online portal called CALVARY CONNECT, and have a chance to sign-up so you can see what is happening throughout the week. Real life change happens in the context of relationships in small groups. In the Bible, believers worshipped in the temple but often ministry happened house to house.

*"You know that I have not hesitated to preach anything that would be helpful to you but have taught you publicly and from house to house."* **Acts 20:20**

We'll get into more specifics later on, but there's is one unifying thing that happens within all of these groups: prayer. 4. Give a personal Invitation to experience Jesus at a weekend service or small group.



## HOW SMALL GROUPS WORK

Depending on the small group, they usually meet once a week or bi-weekly in places all around our city providing a place for you to connect, grow, and discuss the issues and challenges of life. Regardless of your age, interest, or location, we are sure there is a group out there for you. Small groups are also where we pray, care for one another, and are missed if we don't show up! If you would like to join a small group, open up CALVARY CONNECT -->GROUPS and at the bottom of the list, you'll see a button for FIND GROUPS. If you are struggling to find one or would like assistance in finding one, Pastor Vince would love to help you directly and can be contacted on CALVARY CONNECT or by email (vince@calvary.ca). We would love for you to get connected and are more than happy to walk with you through this process.

There are three things you should know about Calvary's small groups:

1. They are "free market" groups. - Our groups are as varied as we are; group leaders use their gifts and passions to create a group that allows others to join with them in serving God, bible study and prayer. Whatever the age, interest, or location there is a group that is just right for you.
2. Special Interest Groups meet seasonally for specific projects. Performing Arts at Christmas, and offer Geocaching in the summer. You get the idea. They are as short and varied as necessary to connect people in the time they have.
3. You can host a group.

We believe that everyone has areas of strength and gifting that could benefit others. The second step is attending a small group and come along side an existing leader. These classes are offered throughout the year to give you an overview of what it takes to start a group. You'll discover that it's easier than you think.

As an example of a home group evening... it may be just under 2hrs long. It would have people arriving and fellowshiping for the first 15 minutes. DVD training and work curriculum for 30 minutes. Fellowship time for 15 minutes, then discussion and prayer for the remaining 45 minutes. Again, the groups are as individual as the leadership and attendees. A group may revolve around fishing or a book club and it would look as different as the people make it.

### **A. ADMINISTRATION**

Spiritual gifts are endowments given by God to His people for accomplishing His purpose on the earth. Spiritual gifts are given for the glory of God.
