

N.B.P.C. BICYCLE POLICY

Peddle bicycles are permitted on the grounds of Nanoose Bay Pentecostal Camp. When riding on the campgrounds, please be aware of others walking through the camp.

We strongly recommend a helmet be worn at all times when riding a bicycle.

Electric motor assisted bicycles are permitted on the campground. They must meet the definition in the B.C. Motor Vehicle Act, have an electric motor of 500 watts or less, have attached and functioning pedals and not travel faster than 32 km per hour without pedaling. The turbo setting must be off when riding on the campgrounds. They must adhere to the 10 km per hour speed limit on the campground.

We strongly recommend a helmet be worn at all times when riding an electric motor assisted bicycle.

Limited speed motorcycles are not permitted on Nanoose Bay Pentecostal Camp campgrounds.
