Marty & Aaron head west looking for new opportunities when tragedy strikes.

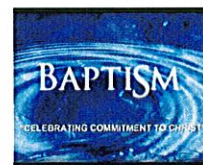
This is the first movie in the “Love Comes Softly” Series.
