RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Assisting the Cabin Leader in supervising a cabin full of up to 14 campers per week.
- Will participate in all activities with cabin as scheduled.
- Sleeps in a cabin each night to provide additional support.
- Assisting in assigned chores and being a good role model for campers

Program Assistant

- Assist program staff with planning and running various programs including wide games, evening programs and campfire.
- Sleeps in a cabin each night to provide additional support.
- Assisting in assigned chores and being a good role model for campers

Kitchen Assistant

- Work with the kitchen staff to assist with basic meal preparation, serving, tuck, dishes and other tasks as required.
- Sleeps in a cabin each night to provide additional support.
- Assisting in assigned chores and being a good role model for campers

NOTES:

As a Volunteer Youth Leader you must accept a large part of the responsibility for your cabin. It is very important for you to take on your share of the workload. Work cooperatively with your Cabin Leader. If a problem arises, talk it over with your Cabin Leader. If it cannot be resolved, talk to the Program Coordinator.
