

BACK TO CHURCH

Sunday

I greet you on behalf of the Trustees, the ReStart task force and the staff of FUMC.

We are happy to announce that our first Sunday back for in-person worship will be this Sunday, June 21st at 9AM for Crossroads and 11AM for Traditional. We need your full cooperation to help make sure that we are able to keep having in-person worship.

This is what we can do together.

- **Mask:** We ask that you wear a mask in the church building at all times. If you cannot do this, then we kindly ask you to wait to attend, until we can lift these restrictions. Remember the mask is more about our neighbor, than about us.
- **Social distancing:** As much as we love to hug and shake hands, we will refrain from this. This includes all touching, no elbow bumps, fist bumps, etc... We are asked to stay 6 feet away from people (other than our family) at all times. This also includes visiting in the Lobby/Foyer of the church. As much as we like to hang around and visit, we will need to exit the building at the end of worship as quickly as possible.
- **Seating:** The ushers will be seating you for worship. We will be seating from front to back in the Sanctuary. This is to maintain the social distancing and keep everyone safe and healthy. Once you are seated, no getting up to visit someone you see. Also no getting up during worship to go to the restroom (unless it is an emergency) The ushers will dismiss you by row at the end of worship.
- **Screening:** Everyone will have their temperature taken when entering the building. If you have a fever of 100.4, we will ask that you come back another Sunday.
- **Time:** Please show up a little earlier than normal to allow for time to check in. The doors will be open at 8:30AM and 10:30AM.
- **Register:** Here is the link. We also ask that you will click this link and register if you plan on attending this Sunday. This is important because it helps us prepare. If you are not coming this Sunday, then there is no need to register.

If you do not feel comfortable coming back to worship yet, I commend you for exercising caution in this trying time. Do not feel ANY guilt over missing in-person worship, we will see you over the internet/TV!

Thank you for your patience during this time. And let us keep our prayers together as seek to move forward!
