

Health and Safety Plan for Bethel Youth Ministry

Location of gathering: Bethel Parking Lot & Youth Room

Maximum number of attendees: 49 (realistically less than 20)

The following procedures will be used:

1. Activities will be done outdoors in the Church parking lot (north side of the building) whenever possible, with the youth room as an alternative meeting space.
2. All doors (including entrance and bathrooms) will be propped open to eliminate the need for attendees to touch door handles.
3. All students will be required to sign in upon arrival, providing basic contact information (name and phone number)
4. Screening of attendees.
 - a. Screening and sign in will take place upon arrival.
 - b. Each attendee will be asked a list of screening questions by the sign in attendant (one of the youth leaders) to ensure all attendees and volunteers are healthy and safe.
 - i. See “Health & Safety Plan Screening Questions” sheet. This sheet will be at the sign in station.
 - c. Any attendees who answer “Yes” to any of the screening questions will be asked to return home.
 - d. All who attend youth will be signed in, stating they have answered “No” to each question.
 - e. The phone numbers of all attendees’ parent/guardian will be kept on file.
5. Hand sanitizer will be available and required upon entrance, as well as recommended throughout the evening.
6. Hand shaking, hugging and all other personal contact will be discouraged and signs will be posted with recommendations for physical distancing.
7. All seating will be marked and arranged to ensure proper physical distancing (6 feet) is maintained.
8. All games and activities will maintain physical distancing.
9. Snacks and drinks will come individually wrapped.
10. Only 1 person at a time will be allowed to be in a bathroom.
11. The youth room and bathrooms will be professionally cleaned after each youth night.
