Scripture: Mark 11:11-26

Discussion Questions

1. During this time of COVID-19, we've been locked out of our church building and separated from congregating. In 1 Corinthians 3, Paul teaches that we are the temple of God. If Jesus were coming to "look around at everything" in your temple, would you be rushing in to make any adjustments? (Discuss the elements of the Temple in Mark 11 that upset Jesus and whether there's any parallel in your life)
2. Fruit: Can you share fruit that you're seeing being developed and is growing in your life as taught in Galatians 5:22 vs. acts of the sinful nature (Galatians 5:19, 20).
3. Faith to move a mountain: Discuss the aspects of faith reflected in "throwing the mountain into the sea" as it relates to Hebrews 11:1-2, Hebrews 11:11, Hebrews 11:13.
4. Forgiveness is to be multi-relational, that is, we are forgiven by God, we forgive others, we receive forgiveness. Why do you think this is so important?
