## Today's lessons:

Genesis 45:1-15

Joseph, whom his brothers had sold as a slave, has become a very important man in Egypt. When now his brothers come to Egypt during a famine, he is able to take care of them, showing them love instead of revenge. This short psalm praises the blessing of a peaceful family life, knowing it doesn't come naturally (see Joseph and his brothers!).

Psalms 133

Romans 11:1-2a, 29-32

For Paul, Israel's failure to recognize Jesus as the Messiah is no different from any other failure to do God's will: it gives God the opportunity to show his mercy.

Matthew 15: (10-20) 21-28

A woman who doesn't take no for an answer becomes an example of faith because she counts solely on the Lord's greatness and mercy.
