The theme: **Serve One Another (St. Peter 4:10)** Zoom is an online program enabling a large number of participants to listen and share, with everyone's face visible. People may phone in to share, but don't see their friends or show their own faces.

Following the service, these reports will be read by a member from each church, regarding parish life, life memberships granted in the parish because of COVID, and in memoriams since last year. Greetings from the Diocesan Executive will be read.

We will begin with a Morning Prayer service led by Rev. Lorne Manweiler. We are indebted to Lorne for hosting the Zoom technology for this gathering.

This will be followed by guest speaker, Suzanne Rumsey, daughter of former St. Timothy rector Gavin Rumsey (1981-92) and now busy working for PWRDF.

Suzanne is a cradle Anglican who grew up in the Diocese of Kootenay, B.C., the traditional and unceded territory of the Ktunaxa (Tun-ah-hah) Nation. She joined PWRDF in 2001 as the Latin America and Caribbean Program Coordinator and in 2010 moved to her current position as Public Engagement Coordinator.

Prior to joining PWRDF, Suzanne worked for a decade with the Inter-Church Committee on Human Rights in Latin America, one of the predecessor coalitions of KAIROS. She is a part-time student at Trinity College, U of T, working on a Masters of Theological Studies, mother of 16-year-old Robin, and in her spare time is a very amateur triathlete (her words). She rode a few thousand miles to raise funds for PWRDF. She lives in the Kensington Market neighbourhood in downtown Toronto.

Discussion will follow, and our Treasurer Barbara Lang will announce the gift of money we will donate to PWRDF in thanksgiving for Suzanne, and her dedicated work.

Early in September you will receive the Regional Booklet, and a note about receiving the Zoom invitation memo. The Booklet will inform why we cannot support Anjali, our foster child.
