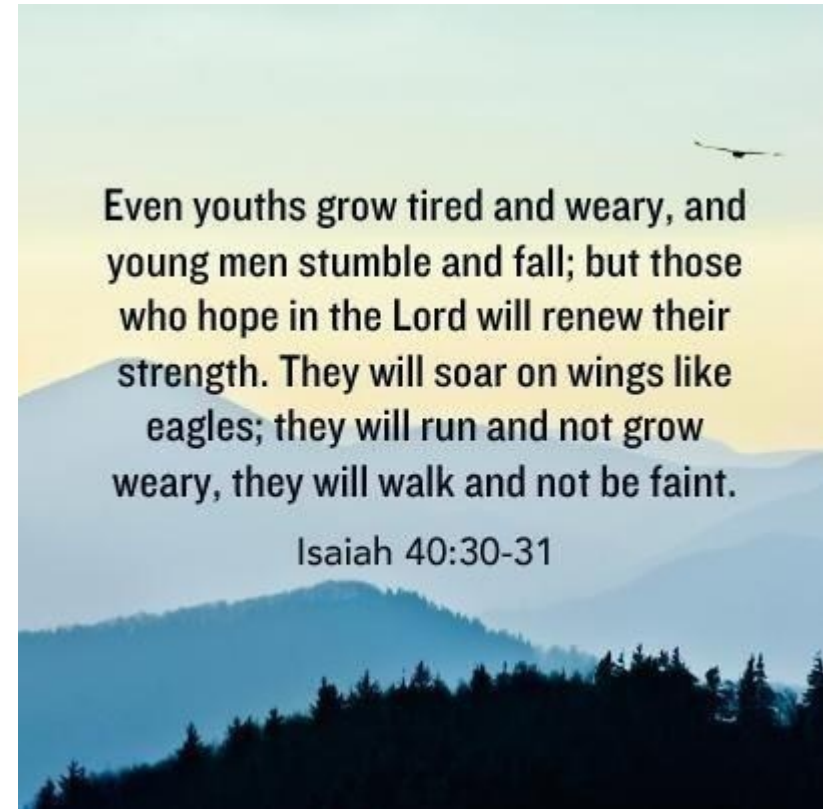

Children's Church Re-Start Delay

We really want to re-start children's church, but due to Covid-19 concerns, we have decided to wait a few weeks until we see how things go in our public schools. If things are going well, our tentative plan is to begin our pre-school class beginning September 27th. This age group will not need to wear masks as their health is less of a concern than the older children. Our K to grade 3 class and grade 4-7 classes will not meet for their normal children's church classes but will work with Esther Cram & other leaders in small groups to begin preparing for our Christmas program in December. They will need to do their best to practice social distancing, & leaders & teachers will likely need to wear masks, but we will confirm this later. As we get closer to 2021, we will reassess the situation with the hope of starting all classes.

Baptism is a public expression of our faith in Jesus Christ. One person has asked to be baptized, but perhaps there are others who would like to take this step?
