Re-opening for services: Here are three things that you will need with you when you walk through the front doors on September 13!

1. The appropriate liturgical book. Sunday Morning at 8:00 will be a BCP service; Sunday morning at 10:00 AM will be a BAS service. Wednesday morning at 9:30 AM will be a BCP service. Books will not be handed out each week, so you need to sign out one of your own and bring it with you to each service! Please arrange to pick up a book prior to September 13.
2. Your mask. Wearing a mask in church will be required by all who come to our services. Please be diligent in ensuring that you come to church with the appropriate mask on.
3. Hand sanitizer. We will have hand sanitizer available – however, it is much more effective if you have your own! Please ensure that you have hand sanitizer with you.
