You may have noticed the new sign that has been placed at the entrance of the church parking lot. It is to replace the old one that had been destroyed in an unfortunate accident earlier in the spring.

Recently we received an email from a neighbour expressing thanks for the new sign and how much it was appreciated by the community. For this person our sign served as a landmark pointing people to our church.

It got me thinking about the importance of signs. In John's gospel, the writer highlights seven signs pointing to the mission and message of Jesus. John included the perfect number of signs:

1. Turning Water into Wine (John 2:1-11)
2. Cleansing the Temple (John 2:12-17)
3. Healing the Nobleman's Son (John 4:46-54)
4. Healing the Lame Man (John 5:1-15)
5. Feeding the Multitude (John 6:1-15)
6. Healing the Blind Man (John 9)
7. Raising Lazarus (John 11)

Each sign is a landmark pointing people to who Jesus is, and what HE will do for the person who opens their lives and surrenders themselves to Jesus person, mission and salvation.
