

# SMALL GROUP APPLICATION

## Goal

Identify reasons to trust God, and tell ways to express trust in Him  
Talk with students about putting into practice the Bible truths discovered in this lesson. Use these **discussion questions** as you lead students to complete one of the activities on the following pages. Conclude the activity with the Life Application Challenge below.

- **What characteristics of God are described in [Psalm 57:1-3,10](#)? How can God's love and faithfulness help us?**
- **What are some things that God has done? How might His actions prove that He can be trusted?**
- **When Jesus, God's Son, lived on Earth how did He demonstrate love and faithfulness?**
- **What are some things kids might depend on or trust in?**
- **Why might people think that having lots of money would give them security? Having lots of friends?**
- **How can you show that you trust in God for your security?**
- **How does trusting God make a difference in how you act toward others? In how you solve your problems? In what you spend your time doing?**

## Life Application Challenge

Today we have talked about the fact that God is trustworthy. Each day this week, I challenge you to spend two minutes, before you go to bed at night, talking to God about times you need to trust Him. Next week, be sure to tell me if you met the challenge! Pray with students, thanking God that we can always trust Him.
