### FIRST READING

**ANITA CHAKRAVORTY**

*Reader* Our first reading is from the Book of Deuteronomy.

For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land, a land with flowing streams, with springs and underground waters welling up in valleys and hills, a land of wheat and barley, of vines and fig trees and pomegranates, a land of olive trees and honey, a land where you may eat bread without scarcity, where you will lack nothing, a land whose stones are iron and from whose hills you may mine copper. You shall eat your fill and bless the Lord your God for the good land that he has given you.

Take care that you do not forget the Lord your God, by failing to keep his commandments, his ordinances, and his statutes, which I am commanding you today. When you have eaten your fill and have built fine houses and live in them, and when your herds and flocks have multiplied, and your silver and gold is multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied, then do not exalt yourself, forgetting the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery, who led you through the great and terrible wilderness, an arid waste-land with poisonous snakes and scorpions. He made water flow for you from flint rock, and fed you in the wilderness with manna that your ancestors did not know, to humble you and to test you, and in the end to do you good. Do not say to yourself, 'My power and the might of my own hand have gained me this wealth.' But remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you power to get wealth, so that he may confirm his covenant that he swore to your ancestors, as he is doing today. Deuteronomy 8.7–18

## **SECOND READING**

**ANITA CHAKRAVORTY**

*Reader* A reading from the Second Letter of Paul to the Corinthians.

The point is this: the one who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the one who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each of you must give as you have made up your mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance, so that by always having enough of everything, you may share abundantly in every good work. As it is written,

'He scatters abroad, he gives to the poor;  
his righteousness endures for ever.'

He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way for your great generosity, which will produce thanksgiving to God through us; for the rendering of this ministry not only supplies the needs of the saints but also overflows with many thanksgivings to God. Through the testing of this ministry you glorify God by your obedience to the confession of the gospel of Christ and by the generosity of your sharing with them and with all others, while they long for you and pray for you because of the surpassing grace of God that he has given you. *The Celebrant prepares the Table while Music is played.*

### **PRAYER OVER THE GIFTS**

*Celebrant* Let us pray

*The community prays in silence.*

*Celebrant* Source of all life,  
the heaven and earth are yours,  
yet you have given us stewardship over all things.  
Receive the symbols of our labour and love  
which we offer you this day,  
in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord.

**All** **Amen.**

### **THE GREAT THANKSGIVING**

*Celebrant* May God be with you.

**All** **And also with you.**

*Celebrant* Lift up your hearts.

**All** **We lift them up to God.**

*Celebrant* Let us give thanks to God our Creator.

**All** **It is right to give our thanks and praise**

*Celebrant* We give you thanks and praise, almighty God,  
for the gift of a world full of wonder,  
and for our life which comes from you.  
By your power you sustain the universe.

**All** **Glory to you for ever and ever.**

*Celebrant* You created us to love you with all our heart, and to love each other as ourselves,  
but we rebel against you by the evil that we do.

In Jesus, your Son,  
you bring healing to our world  
and gather us into one great family.  
Therefore, with all who serve you on earth and in heaven,  
we praise your wonderful name, as we say,

*All* **Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,  
heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest.**

**Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.  
Hosanna in the highest.**

*Celebrant* We give you thanks and praise, loving Father,  
because in sending Jesus, your Son, to us  
you showed us how much you love us.  
He cares for the poor and the hungry.  
He suffers with the sick and the rejected.  
Betrayed and forsaken, he did not strike back  
but overcame hatred with love.

On the cross  
he defeated the power of sin and death.  
By raising him from the dead  
you show us the power of your love to bring new life to all your people.

*All* **Glory to you for ever and ever.**

*Celebrant* On the night before he gave up his life for us,  
Jesus, at supper with his friends,  
took bread, gave thanks to you, broke it, and gave it to them,  
saying, "Take this, all of you, and eat it:  
this is my body which is given for you."

After supper, Jesus took the cup of wine, said the blessing,  
gave it to his friends, and said, "Drink this, all of you:  
this is the cup of my blood,  
the blood of the new and eternal covenant,

which is shed for you and for many,  
so that sins may be forgiven.  
Do this in memory of me.”

*All* **Glory to you for ever and ever.**

*Celebrant* Gracious God,  
with this bread and wine  
we celebrate the death and resurrection of Jesus,  
and we offer ourselves to you in him.

Send your Holy Spirit on us and on these gifts,  
that we may know the presence of Jesus  
in the breaking of bread, and share in the life  
of the family of your children.

*All* **Glory to you for ever and ever.**

*Celebrant* Father, you call us to be your servants;  
fill us with the courage and love of Jesus,  
that all the world may gather in joy  
at the table of your kingdom.

We sing your praise, almighty Father, through Jesus, our Lord,  
in the power of the Holy Spirit, now and for ever.

*All* **Glory to you for ever and ever. Amen.**

### **THE LORD'S PRAYER**

*Celebrant* As our Saviour taught us, let us pray.

*All* **Our Father in heaven,  
hallowed be your name, your kingdom come,  
your will be done,  
on earth as in heaven.  
Give us today our daily bread.  
Forgive us our sins  
as we forgive those who sin against us.  
Save us from the time of trial,  
and deliver us from evil.  
For the kingdom, the power,  
and the glory are yours,  
now and for ever. Amen.**

## **THE BREAKING OF THE BREAD**

*The Celebrant breaks the consecrated bread.*

*Celebrant* Be present, be present, Lord Jesus Christ, crucified and risen;  
**All**           **make yourself known in the breaking of bread.**

## **THE INVITATION**

*Celebrant* This is the table, not of the righteous, but of the poor in spirit.  
It is made ready for those who love God and who want to love God more.

So come, you who have much faith and you who have little,  
You who have been here often  
and you who have not been for a long time or ever before,  
You who have tried to follow and all of us who have failed.  
Come, not because the Church invites you;  
It is Christ who invites you to be known and fed here.

The gifts of God for the people of God  
**All**           **Thanks be to God.**

## **THE COMMUNION**

*The Celebrant will explain how the distribution will take place. Communion is received in one kind at the moment.*

*Those receiving will be directed when to leave their seats and should be wearing a face covering.*

*The bread is received and taken back to your seat for consumption.*

*The Celebrant will sanitize their hands before and after the distribution and wear a cloth face covering.*

*Music will be played during the distribution.*

Glory to God from generation to generation,  
in the Church and in Christ Jesus  
for ever and ever. Amen.
