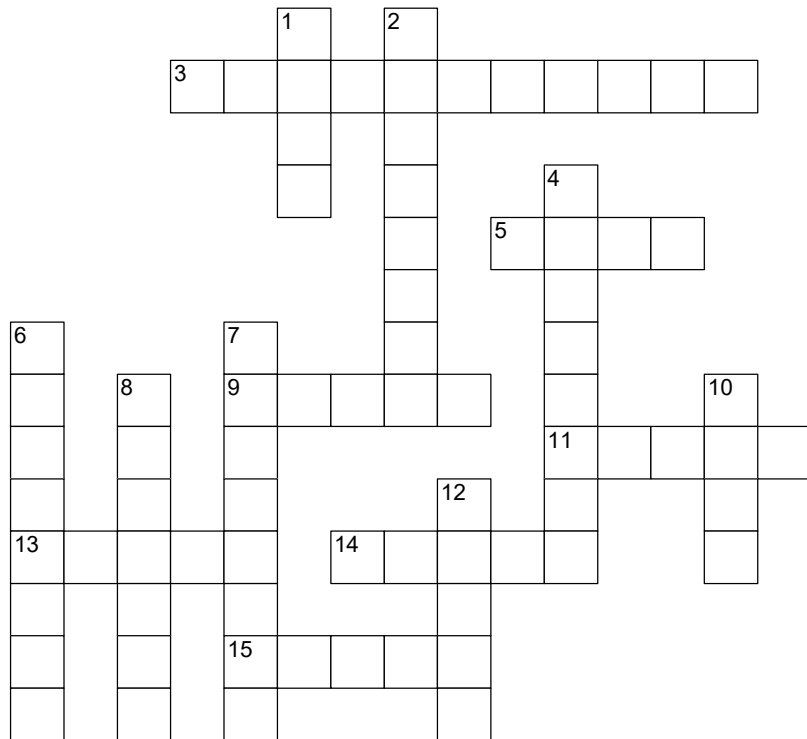


# INTERCESSION

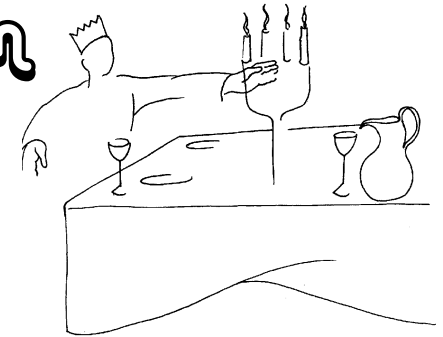

## Today's lessons:

- Exodus 32:1-14 While Moses is on Mount Sinai, receiving the Ten Commandments, the people get Aaron to make a god they can see, the Golden Calf. When Moses returns, he tries to save the people from God's anger.
- Psalms 106:1-6, 19-23 It's amazing how God continues to love his people in spite of all the stupid and wicked things they keep on doing.
- Philippians 4:1-9 At the end of his letter from prison, the apostle Paul reminds the Philippians to lead lives that reflect their joy about Jesus Christ.
