### **Discussion questions:**

1. Where in the "lifecycle of hope" do you often get stuck? Why do you think that is? What can you do about it?
2. From the various fears listed in vss 2-3, which ones tend to be your go-to response to difficulty or trials? What is the Biblical truth that opposes that fear?
3. What do you anticipate about 'seeing His face' (v7)? What images come to your mind when you think of seeing His face? One day we will 'see His face' in heaven, but in this world, what would 'seeing His face' look like? Why don't we 'see His face' more often do you think?
4. If you're comfortable doing so, share with your group some areas of your life that could use 'theological reflection' as described in this morning's message. Choose one to ask your group to ask you about next week to provide accountability for doing so.
5. As a group list all of the ways you are aware of that God is using this pandemic for His glory and for the good of His children. Spend some time in praise for these!
6. Spend some time brainstorming in your group for ideas of how God might wish us as the PTC to respond to this pandemic. Which of these ideas do you believe we as a church should pursue?

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
