Sermon: Ask Anything Part 6 | Why believe in a God who allows evil & suffering?

Date: Oct 25, 2020

Scripture: Romans 8:18-25

SERMON QUESTIONS:

1. What did the Spirit teach you through the sermon on Sunday?
2. Before this Sunday's sermon, how would you have answered the question, "Why doesn't God do something about all the evil and suffering in the world?"
3. When investigating the problem of evil, the non-Christian actually has a bigger problem than the Christian does. How so?
4. How does the Hindu worldview fail to adequately answer the problem of evil?
5. What were the four candles that Christianity lights up? Of these four reasons, what did you find the most compelling?
6. James 1:2-3 calls us to find joy in our trials and suffering. Can you share a time when you have suffered but God has given you joy in the midst of it?
7. Do you feel better equipped to answer this question the next time it comes up in a discussion? Explain.

ACCOUNTABILITY QUESTIONS:

1. Describe a struggle in your Christian walk this week.
2. Have you given into temptation since we met last? Is there anything the Lord is leading you to confess?
3. How has your time of Bible study and prayer been?
4. Who has God put in your life that you need to share the gospel with?

1. What do you need prayer for?
2. Who are you praying for? (Who has God put in your life that you need to share the gospel and life with?)
