- ◆ **Sun. Oct. 5th** - special service begins at 2:30 pm at St. Michael's, then procession to St. Cyprian's to celebrate the Eucharist, followed by catered fellowship dinner

THE AMALGAMATION PARADE

On Sunday, October 5th, a special service will begin with the deconsecration of the church at 2:30 p.m. at St. Michael and All Angels, Archbishop Barry Curtis presiding. The historic procession from St. Michael's to St. Cyprian's will start at about 3:15 p.m. We hope to be led by a marching band and banners for a walk that should take about 1 ½ hours.
