week two: "devoted to the apostles' teaching"  
*follow-up discussion questions*

Acts 2:42 – "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching..."

- What was something specific from the message this past Sunday that connected with us (an encouragement, a challenge, a new way of thinking)? Were there any questions that stirred up for us?
- How important has the Apostles' teaching been to **our** lives with God? (think about the birth, growth, struggles and sustenance of your faith).
- What personal or corporate practices/disciplines **have been** most helpful in fueling this devotion in our lives?
- What **works against** us being devoted to the apostles' teaching? (personally and culturally – get honest.)
- Are there any practices or disciplines that **you** would love to learn and explore together to help **you** grow in being devoted to the apostles' teaching?
- How could we be intentional in our friendship and times together to fuel this devotion in our lives?

**Practicing our Faith Together:**

*Have someone read aloud Hebrews 10:19-25. Linger on the three "Let us" invitations (vs.22, 23, 24). Talk together about how these three invitations relate to one another in our own lives. And then pray into the invitations for one another [i.e. "God, \_\_\_ lacks a desire to 'draw near' these days. Use our friendship to renew his/her desire to experience Your friendship..."].*
