## COVID-19 Indoor Service Protocol

*The following requirements must be observed by all who attend*

- A maximum of 35 persons can attend each service
  - Attending in person is optional (no one is required to attend). Those over the age of 65 and those with underlying health conditions (e.g., high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma, and compromised immune system) are encouraged to attend online rather than in person.
  - Anyone who is sick or feels sick **must not attend**.
  - Masks/face coverings are **required** in the building, unless you are eating.
  - People of different families must stay at least 2 metres (6 feet) apart at all times. If both people reach out and can touch each other, that is far too close. Treat all others (and yourself) as if they (and you) are potentially infectious.
  - You must sit in the location you are assigned by an usher.
  - Please follow the signs and directions as you move about the building.
  - Bathrooms are reserved for emergency use only.
  - Children must remain with their parents or a member of their household.
  - Families and individuals who are unable to commit to these guidelines will be invited to join us for worship from home via Zoom: <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/371758057>
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- There will be no access to the kitchen
  - No food may be shared outside of one's own family or bubble
  - Please sit at an assigned area for dinner
