Sunday RE-Gathering

Starting June 21, we are going to take first steps towards gathering in person as a community!

After a number of months gathering on zoom, we are so excited to be able to take some initial steps toward worshipping together in person. As of May 20th, the BC Government is allowing for person religious services to be held with physical distancing and a maximum of groups of 50 people.

With this in mind we are going to take next steps by hosting our weekly zoom gathering from Mike and Sara's home. Starting Sunday, you are welcome to join us in person at Mike and Sara's or from home as families or small groups using zoom.

As we gather we will be following these recommended measures in order to keep our community safe and healthy:

1. Safe Social Distancing - 2m

- We will setup so that those gathering are 6m apart
- Families will need to sit together, and children remain with their parents. We aren't able to gather the kids for a separate program at this time.

2. Please wear a mask

3. We will be making hand sanitizer available

4. For the time being we won't be making coffee or treats available

5. If you are sick, please stay at home and join us on zoom

When we celebrate the Eucharist together those gathered at Mike and Sara's will be served during the service. Those being served will remain where they are and Father Chad will come to them to serve bread dipped in wine. Following the service eucharist will be served out front of Mike and Sara's for those who have joined us on online.

The inability to gather together in worship this past few months has highlighted for us the importance of being together. Ours is a corporate faith and a shared life, and we are excited to find safe and responsible ways to do be together again!
