



Community Group Questions
February 9, 2014
Zephaniah 3

1. Read Zephaniah 3 together. What stands out to you in this chapter? What questions come to mind? What do you agree with? Is there anything that troubles you?
2. Verses 1-8 again show the judgment of God against his people. Do you think most Christians are aware of the judgment that will happen when Jesus returns? Do we talk about it enough? Too much? Read Revelation 20:11-15 to get a glimpse of judgment that will happen.
3. Verses 9-13 describe the type of person God is going to spare in his judgment. Pastor Andrew said on Sunday that this description should fit all of us as followers of Christ. Do you agree? Read 1 Peter 5:5 and James 4:6. Are most Christians humble? Does it matter?
4. 1 John 4:10 says that God sent Jesus to be the propitiation for our sins. This means that God poured out his wrath of Jesus. Does this seem harsh? Why do some Christians reject propitiation? (some call it divine child abuse).
5. Pastor Andrew said on Sunday that there is no more wrath for those who believe in Jesus. This means for those who don't believe in Jesus, the wrath of God remains on them. Do you agree with this? Or is all of God's wrath gone? Read John 3:36 and Romans 2:5.
6. Zephaniah 3:17 tells us that God rejoices over us. Do most Christians believe God delights in them? Or do they still think God is disappointed in their sin? Why is it crucial to understand God no longer sees your sin when you trust in Jesus?
