

## Bishop Ford Memorial Garden

Located on a hilltop overlooking the town of Cochrane, the centrepiece of the Bishop Ford Memorial Garden will be a 4-sided, 72-niche granite columbarium to hold the urns of your loved ones in a safe and secure location.



The Church is now selling niches in this beautiful columbarium. We anticipate the Bishop Ford Memorial Garden will be completed in the fall of 2020.

*From earliest times, Christians have gathered and prayed at the final resting places of their deceased. This seemed strange to their neighbours. But the scriptures told these early Christians that Christ, at his death and resurrection “descended to the dead” and brought new life there. ## Columbarium Niches

Each niche measures 30 cm x 30 cm x 40 cm (12" x 12" x 16") to allow families to have the flexibility to accommodate either one or two urns.



The concealed inner aluminum door locking system provides families with peace of mind that their loved ones' ashes will be safely secured.

Niches can be purchased at any time for future use.

### Niche Pricing

Single           \$2,799 plus GST  
includes open and close for one urn

Double           \$3,299 plus GST  
includes open and close for two urns

Payable at time of purchase

## Inscriptions

Granite cover plates will be removed for laser engraving and, within our guidelines, can be custom designed by the family.

- A specified font will be used for all inscribed text.
- Families will have the option to include a graphic or picture of their loved one. There will be a variety of art imagery to choose from.
- All text and imagery must be laser etched to allow for finer artistic detail and images of people.
- Approved parameters do not allow for flower vases on face plates.

To maximize flexibility, inscriptions will be coordinated by the family in conjunction with the specified engraver. The engraving cost (currently estimated between \$300 and \$500 but subject to change) will be invoiced directly to the family, with price based on the graphics chosen and the volume of text being inscribed. Face plate designs will be subject to approval to ensure they conform to the parameters set out by All Saints.

At the time of engraving, All Saints will remove the face plate, send it to the engraver and reinstall it. The cost of this service is included in the niche pricing.

## Location

The Bishop Ford Memorial Garden will be located on the grounds of All Saints Anglican Church in Cochrane, Alberta, and will be administered by the Church. It will be a private, gated area between the Church office wing and the Parish House.



Family members will be able to gather around an altar for a service of remembrance in the Garden. Benches will provide an opportunity for loved ones to sit and enjoy the serenity of the location.

To preserve the beauty of the Garden, no vases, flowers bouquets or other items can be placed on the columbarium or left within the Garden. We welcome memorial flowers on the All Saints altar during Sunday services.

Opportunities, such as bench markers and landscaping features, will be available within the Garden to memorialize loved ones.
