



DISCUSSION GUIDE

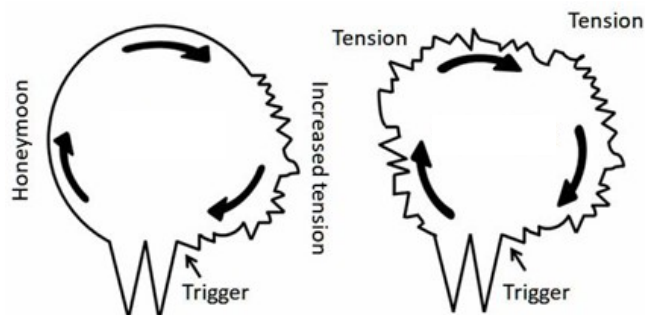

1) In reflecting over what you heard in the message, what stories come to mind?

2) This drawing below can apply to a marriage or any other relationship. What family or church relationship have you observed that these diagrams reflect all or a part of?



3) Trust-levels and the way we manage power are inseparable. What have you done in your family or church or workplace to give away power (empower others)?

4) Dan and Dan describe three categories of people: the wise, the foolish, and the evil. Think of three individuals you think would fit in each of the categories. What's been your pattern of interacting with people in each category?

5) Share a story in your journey where someone broke your trust and they earned it back. Or, share a story where you broke someone's trust and you earned it back.

6) What do you need from others to more easily trust them? What would you yourself need to do to build a higher level of trust with people around you?
