



How to Read the Bible for All It's Worth Course Outline

Description

This five-week exploration through the Old and New Testament will take you through the basics of understanding how to read and interpret the Bible as well as provide a framework for engaging with God's Word. You will be introduced to practices such as praying and journaling scripture, methods of study that lead to transformation as well as information.

The individual courses build on each other but may be taken individually; these courses will be made available online on the KAC Resources pages.

You will learn:

- An awareness of the Bible
- An understanding of place as interpreter
- A framework for engagement with the Bible
- A foundation for Bible study
- An appreciation for the need to study the Bible
- A awareness of how to study the Bible
- An appreciation of the message of the Old Testament
- An overview of the major parts of the Old Testament and their purpose in the library of Scripture
- An appreciation of how to properly engage with Old Testament text
- An appreciation of the message of the New Testament
- An overview of the major parts of the New Testament and their purpose in the library of Scripture
- An appreciation of how to properly engage with the texts of the New Testament
- An awareness of the need to study for transformation as well as gaining information
- Awaken a passion to engage Scripture for life change
- A overview of a method that focuses on prayer and journaling for personal reflections and applications

Learning Outcomes

You will become competent in understanding how to read the Bible, and the many factors to consider and tools to employ in studying and interpreting the text. You will be able to apply your new knowledge and skills as you engage in the Text and initiate practises that lead to transformation. You will have the capacity and capability to study the Word of God, with an appreciation of the entire story, literary forms, messages, translations, that together, set you up to know Jesus more intimately.
