2020 has been a challenging year for all, but we still have a lot to be thankful for. I am thankful for all of you, for your prayers, and your support of The Vault. Your generous giving over the last few months continues to amaze me. It is because of you, your prayers, and the will of God that we are able to be open for the teens of Washington and provide a safe, positive, Christ-like environment for them amongst all the challenges and confusion that is happening around us. Again, thank you!

We were able to reopen on September 8th, after about six months of being closed. We are currently open Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 3 to 6:30 pm. We are seeing about ten teens come in on an average afternoon. Masks, temperature checks, and signing in are required before entry. Many of our teens returned to The Vault immediately upon reopening. We have several students who are participating in distance learning, but their families are happily allowing them to come to The Vault. Several parents told me how happy they are that we've reopened.



We are still providing snacks, many of which are provided by the FDC Food Pantry and other individuals, (Thank You). We still have God Squad (our version of Bible Study), games, homework help, and much more. Thank you for helping us maintain a place downtown for the youth of Washington. Your generosity has not gone unnoticed by them either. Many have been asking how and why people they've never met would keep a place like The Vault open after being closed for so long. This question has opened up some interesting discussions during our Bible Study, and opened the door to discussing the Gospel, the love of Christ and what the church actually does.



We have a few very dedicated volunteers; Andrea, Linda, and even Pastor Jerry, come in to help us during the week. But we are still in need of help. We have had to close on Wednesdays due to changes in circumstance for some of our volunteers. Donations of gift cards for small meals, snacks, and monetary donations to cover expenses are also greatly appreciated.
