Disciplinary Policy

Salt Creek Baptist Church Children's Ministries bases its expectations for students on the biblical principal taught in *Luke 6:31: Do to others as you would have them do to you.*

This includes being Respectful, Kind, Obedient, and Safe.

Children who exhibit these behaviors and make efforts toward following these expectations will receive positive reinforcement in the form of verbal praise and encouragement and on occasion stickers, treats, or prizes. Children who consistently fail to meet these expectations or are defiant will experience the following consequences:

1. Verbal Warning
2. Time Out
3. Loss of Privilege
4. Discussion with parent and possible one week "break" from class

It is very important that the church has a current phone number and emergency contact information on file for your child. It is also important for you to discuss these expectations and consequences at home with your child to reinforce their importance. We desire for all children who attend our programs to feel safe, welcome, and loved. Having clear expectations and boundaries for our students help us to maintain a safe and comfortable environment for kids and volunteers alike.
