During the COVID -19 pandemic and our church's re-opening, there have been a lot of very good questions. These are our best answers.

Here are some of the things we are doing.

- We will have our Re-Start team to welcome our congregation, and to check in with them on their health, make sure they are wearing a mask, and offer hand sanitizer.
- The Re-Start team will be sanitizing and cleaning the sanctuary between each service to guarantee the cleanest and safest environment we can offer.
- We will still have our -tech and worship teams serving on Sundays, but they will be distanced and wearing masks.

Here are some basic starting points.

- If you are at all sick, stay home.
- Wash your hands and maintain your social distance.
- As careful as we are, we are equally excited. We hope you will share this.

Will there be coffee?

To limit contact, we will not be serving coffee, but we encourage you to bring your own.

How will Communion work?

Whenever we take Communion together, we will provide pre-packaged Communion elements.

Will there be prayer ministry?

There will be, but there will not be laying on of hands.

Are new guests welcome?

A thousand times yes! As we are confined to reserved seating for each service we still want to prioritize our desire for newcomers and a welcoming environment.

Will the washrooms be accessible?

Yes, and they will be sanitized before each service. They will also have a two person occupancy limit, and a one way hallway leading to the washrooms. After leaving the washroom you will need to exit the building and re-enter through the designated entry.

Are face masks required?

Yes. Whatever your opinions are on masks, we are following provincial recommendations and requiring masks at all times when inside the building. If you do not have a mask, you will be provided one. However, we ask you to bring your own as our inventory is not unlimited.

Will there be kids ministry?

At this time, no. But kids are welcome to join the service!

Before and after the service.

Pre-service prayer will be on for those who are registered for the service, but there can unfortunately be no loitering in the lobby before or after the service.
