**JUNE 7, 2020 - THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY**

The Holy Trinity is the most profound mystery of our Faith, that is to say it's the centre our faith as Christians, "the mystery of God in himself. ...the source of all the other mysteries of faith" (*Catechism*, 234). It's also the most complicated mystery of our Faith.

By "mystery" I don't mean it's a puzzle or thing to be solved, but a belief based on Divine Revelation. **We only know about the Trinity because Jesus spoke about it**; it isn't something we could know by reason alone. Jesus spoke frequently of His Father and said the *Spirit of truth* would teach us (Jn 14:16-17; 16:13). At the great Commission, He told us to Baptise *in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit* (Mt 28:19).

But these three Persons aren't separate gods; they're one God. They're one because they have the same 'nature': they're *consubstantial*, as we say in the Nicene Creed. That's why they're Trinity: 'tri-unity', 'three-in-one'. Their distinction is according to relationship.

**The Father** is 'Father' not because He's male but because He's the source and origin of all things and loves all His children (*Catechism*, 239). As St. John says, *God is love* (1 Jn 4:8), and love necessarily pours itself out to the object of affection.

**The Son**, the *beloved*, is the object of the Father's affection and is *begotten* by this love. This begetting is what makes the Father 'Father' and the Son 'Son'. They're distinct because they relate to one another as Father and Son, as the *One who loves* and the *One who is loved and loves in return*.

**The Spirit**, in this analogy, is the *Love* that binds them, the *Love* poured from Father to Son, and from Son to Father. Now you can see why it's the most complicated mystery of our faith. As we rejoice in this great mystery of God's divine love, may we contemplate it so as to grow in our love for the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
