

Constitution of Sorrento Centre, Anglican Church of Canada (the "Society")

1. The name of the Society is Sorrento Centre, Anglican Church of Canada.

2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - a. To provide an ongoing Christian community to the glory of God in which people may discover, enrich and fulfill their vocation as members of the Body of Christ in the world; and be open and responsive to the needs of that world.

 - b. To promote Christian knowledge and development by:
 - Providing opportunities for learning through educational events where there is freedom to enquire, openness to ecumenical encounter, and wherein people can be nourished within a Christian community.

 - Providing a place where people can holiday.

 - Providing opportunities for spiritual retreat.

 - Providing resources for the church at large in the areas of leadership training, ministry development and consultation services.

 - c. To acquire, hold, develop, maintain and manage property, both real and personal, for the operation of Sorrento Centre.
