

MOSAIC CHURCH - VIRUS REDUCTION STRATEGY – AS OF SEPT 25, 2020

1) Step One - Personal

- All people admitted to the premises are required to maintain 2 meters of physical distance from one another. Capacity - 50 people permitted OR number able to retain 2m physical distance, whichever is fewer.
- All people admitted to the Church are strongly encouraged to wear a mask. Masks are required for corporate singing.
- Sanitization OR washing of hands is required upon entry.
- ALL people must sign in and leave a contact number, email address, or location to be contacted at for contact tracing.
- Self-assessment of Covid-19 symptoms published by BC CDC. Please stay home if you have these symptoms.

Prevent the spread of COVID-19

- Wash your hands regularly.
- Avoid touching your face, eyes, nose or mouth.
- Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing.
- Keep a physical distance of about 2 metres between yourself and others.
- Avoid handshakes and hugs (wave instead).

2) Step Two – Setup

- All surfaces need to be cleaned with hospital grade cleaner or Lysol or one cup bleach to three cups water.
 - Please note that bleach based solutions can be harmful to wood surfaces. Wood surfaces should be cleaned with a 70% alcohol based disinfectant. Do not use 90%+ alcohol solutions.
- Tables and bathrooms are to be sanitized before opening.
- Chairs should be placed no less than 2 meters apart

3) Step Three – Food and Beverage

- All food and beverage are served – no self-service
- All food is pre-packed and in individual snack packs
- Drinks will be prepared and served by 1 person

4) Step Four – Clean Up

- Tables and bathrooms are to be sanitized before opening.
- Last person leaving wipes down the light switches and the door handles leaving the church. Plus wiping down the alarm code pad.
