## DIGGING IN

5. Read through Acts 4:1-31. Circle/ take note of the times the word “but” is used. Contemplate the significance of that word as it pertains to God working progressing even amidst the challenges we endure. What are some ways that word could be used to describe God’s work in and through your life right now?

## MAKING IT REAL

6. What’s an area of my life where I need to be reminded about the sovereignty of God right now?
7. How does this passage help me understand how and when it’s appropriate to bypass human authority in order to answer to the higher authority of God?
8. Just as Peter, John, and their friends *lifted their voices together to God* in prayer, follow their model and join in prayer together, asking God to do what He alone can do so we can continue to testify to Him.
