Joshua 24:1–3a, 14–25 At the end of his life Joshua calls the people together once more, warning them against worshipping other gods. And the people promise to serve only the God who led them out of Egypt. One generation tells the next about what God has done for them.

Psalm 78:1–7

1 Thessalonians 4:13–18 Some of the Thessalonians are concerned for those Christians who have died: weren't they promised to live with Jesus Christ forever?! Paul assures them that they will rise from the dead just like Jesus himself did.

Matthew 25:1–13 Jesus tells his disciples about his own second coming: he might come later than they expect. They will have to be ready for waiting – and for him coming any time!

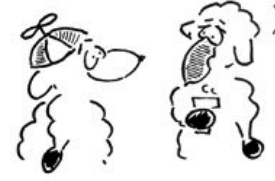

But Joshua is sceptical:

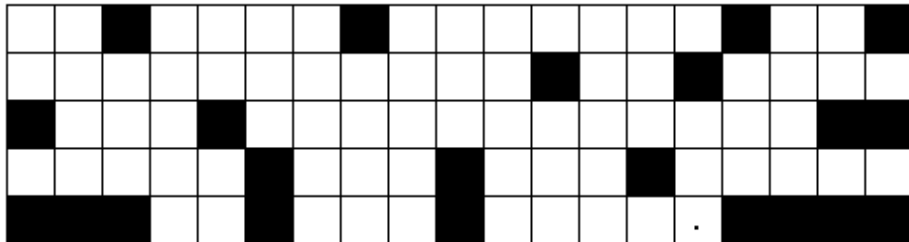
