COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

Trinity Baptist Church is a wonderful community of believers, who care for one another and for those we reach with the Gospel. We join with everyone in British Columbia in our support of our frontline workers and provincial medical experts. We share the same desire to protect each other from COVID-19.

As restrictions on gatherings are loosened, we encourage the restart of some face-to-face meetings. We understand that not everyone is comfortable with this yet, and we support those who may feel this way. If you do not feel ready to engage in face-to-face meetings, please continue to stay home and join us through online, digital connections.

For the protection of one another, pastors, staff, and families, while on Trinity Baptist Church Daycare property, here are some safety plans we implemented:

- Only 50 people allowed to attend any special gatherings in our daycare.
- We have considered virtual meetings eg. DC Committee meetings, parent, staff and other professionals working with the children.
- Rescheduling work tasks and limiting the number of attendees in our daycare center eg. Practicum students only 2 allowed at a time and 1 volunteer.
- We have established and posted an occupancy limit for common areas such as washrooms, meeting rooms and break rooms. Men's washroom only 1 person at a time. Women's washroom only 2 people at time.
- Unnecessary visits to our daycare are not allowed until further notice.
- We have a new designated drop off and pick up area for our parents.
- All guests, children, staff, practicum students and volunteers are advised to wash their hands upon arrival at our center. Frequent handwashing is recommended when needed.
- Masks are not mandatory to wear in our facility. It is a personal choice. We understand the limitations of masks to protect the wearer from respiratory droplets. We understand that masks should only be considered when other control measures cannot be implemented.

- We have implemented measures to keep staff, children, practicum students, volunteers and other professionals at least 2 metres apart, wherever possible.
- We have clearly communicated the restricted areas, entering and exiting the church building through signage.
- Only the gym, lounge and hallway washrooms are available. The gym and lounge cannot be used at the same time.
- To maintain strict 2m social distance, only 35 people can use the gym at any time, and only 10 can use the lounge at any time.

Please Do Not Enter the Church Building or Trinity House:

- If you have any symptoms of COVID-19, including fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, and painful swallowing.
- If you or a family or household member are under the direction of the provincial health officer to self-isolate.
- If you have arrived from outside Canada or have been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days. Please self-isolate and monitor for symptoms for 14 days.

If any symptoms occur while on church property or within 72 hours of being on church property, please report immediately to the church office, church custodian, or one of the pastors. Proper cleaning protocols can be put in place immediately to ensure the building is safe for all.
