Opening Discussion:

Message on Acts 1 and 2

Read aloud together, taking turns with paragraphs at a time both full chapters of Acts 1 & @ in your Bibles.

Focus:

- Acts 1:6-8
 - Share your thots about what jumps at you Acts chapter 1 and then specifically vs 6-8
 - How do you feel about the point Jesus makes, “You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes to you...”?
 - The question is not, “Will you be a witness?” but “What kind of witness will you be?” Share your thoughts.
- Acts 2:42-47
 - Share your thots about what jumps at you Acts chapter 2 and then specifically vs 42-47
 - List what the church did, and how they did it.

Discuss the following statements Pastor Terry made in his message:

- “Learning from God’s Word and a full experience of the Spirit are not mutually exclusive.”
- “If you have only the Word of God you dry up. If you have only the Spirit of God you blow up. If you have both, you grow up.”
- Fellowship is more than just socializing, it is sharing life and true involvement with one another.
- “He who loves his dream of the community more than the Christian community itself becomes a destroyer of the latter.” Dietrich Bonhoeffer
