1. Read Matthew 13:44. What is the treasure in the field? Why is it significant that the man goes back and sells everything to buy the field?
2. Why does Jesus include "in his joy" he buys the field. What does it mean to treasure Jesus like this?
3. How would you describe a worldview? Why is it significant to understand that everyone has a worldview?
4. What was Paul's worldview and how did it affect his attitude while he was in prison?
5. How does the biblical worldview help you interpret your present situation? How does it affect the way you view the future?
6. In our passage this week, Paul wrestled with life and death, and resolved that he was to remain on earth to continue the work of advancing the gospel among the Gentiles. What are your thoughts about telling people about Jesus? Do you think this is important for us today? Is it the reason we are still here on earth? Does a look at your past week show that evangelism is a priority to you?
