**Lutheran Church of Our Saviour is a member of MACG** along with the Synod of Alberta. Pastor Lee and Katharine co-chair The Research Action team on Seniors the alliance is currently working on.

**Our Guiding Mission team** here at LCOS also forms part of a Core Team. Core teams are teams in each member institution that connect their organization to MACG. The teams learn to use community organizing skills to strengthen their organization and discover how they can have an impact on their local communities. Core teams are developed through training and support provided by MACG. The next free training session is on Thursday Oct 26th from 7:00 to 9:00 pm at Knox United Church.



**If you are interested in learning more** about any aspect of MACG be sure to speak to Ryan after the Service, Pastor Lee, Katharine, Darren Tenor or Alice Rodier which are all actively involved.

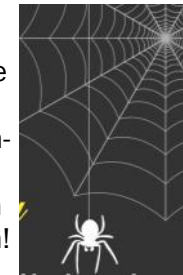


### Are you a Mom of a baby or preschooler? Do you miss MOPS?
