– Disaster & Hope –
Genesis 5:1-5, 28 – 6:8

(Choose the most appropriate questions below for discussion – you don't need to do them all :)

1. Discuss or consider how the Holy Spirit spoke to you through the passage or sermon.
2. God preserves the “seed” of messiah through Seth (compare 3:15 & 4:25; ‘offspring’ = ‘seed’). What is significant about this?
3. Human beings break boundaries: first through eating forbidden fruit (3:6) and secondly, through inter-breeding with Nephilim (angelic beings) (6:2, see Gen 1:24-25). Why is this a problem? [hint: name = role, 2:19]
4. The state of things on earth is summed up in 6:5. Discuss how this may describe today?
 - a) How might this describe your own life and circumstances?
5. What were you personally created to be / do? [hint: consider 1 Cor 7:17-24]
 - a) Are you willing to take on the role God purposed for you? Discuss both positive and negative aspects of this.
 - b) How do you live joyfully in who you are, what you do, and where God has placed you.
