- 2 Pacific Youth's New Way of Connecting, With social distancing being implemented to slow down the spread of the COVID-19 virus in our communities, we had to reimagine and rethink how we were going to gather as a youth group in the foreseeable future. To ensure that we were able to check-in with each other, pray for one another and encourage each other on a weekly basis during these difficult times, we meet weekly via Zoom.
- 2 Pacific Youth Minecraft Server Launched. Seth DeWitt, one of our amazing youth, created and launched a Pacific Youth Minecraft server, which gave our teens access to a platform to play games together virtually.
