JOB DESCRIPTION:

Faith Formation Volunteer

GOAL OF POSITION

Volunteers in this Ministry are caring adults who love their faith and have a desire to share their faith with others. The goal of the Faith Formation Volunteer (catechist) is to creatively engage all students and/or adults in our Catholic faith.

RESPONSIBLE TO

Faith Formation Leader, Ministry Liaison for Faith Formation, and Pastor

JOB DESCRIPTION

Volunteers are responsible for:

- 1. Organizing ministry procedures and maintain a system of documentation*
- 2. Overseeing those involved in Faith Formation in the parish, including, but not limited to, Sacramental Preparation;*
- 3. To develop, plan and prepare lessons for the various programs offered for Faith Formation;*
- 4. Organize meeting space if required, etc.*

TIME REQUIRED

1 - 2 hours/week from September to June, with additional hours in preparation for Sacraments. Includes some weekends and some evenings.

LENGTH OF COMMITMENT

1 year, renewable

TRAINING PROVIDED

Standard parish orientation, leadership and ministry-specific training provided by the Pastor and Faith Formation Leader

QUALIFICATIONS AND SPECIAL SKILLS

- 1. Is a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church in good standing and an active member of OLPH Parish*
- 2. Has the related education and/or experience to perform basic religious education responsibilities*
