- <sup>7</sup> All who worship images are put to shame, those who boast in idols— worship him, all you gods!
- <sup>8</sup> Zion hears and rejoices and the villages of Judah are glad because of your judgments, Lord. <sup>9</sup> For you, Lord, are the Most High over a

- <sup>10</sup> Let those who love the Lord hate evil, for he guards the lives of his faithful ones and delivers them from the hand of the wicked.

<sup>7</sup> "Teacher," they asked, "when will these things happen? And what will be the sign that they are about to take place?"

<sup>8</sup> He replied: "Watch out that you are not deceived. For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am he,' and, 'The time is near.' Do not follow them.
