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Thanks for sharing these! So Joe Mally (co-creator, KidMin pastor and friend) and I started **Kid-tivity** a couple of years ago to create activity books for kids and families to use that would offer biblical truth and stories in a fun and accessible way. The intent - specifically with these Christmas books - was that children's ministry leaders could easily print and gift them as part of a "goodie" bag they pass out during Christmas (Eve) services OR email them to parents as a way of helping them celebrate the Christmas Story at home!

We have used these at St. Paul's for the last 2 years (we print and pass out a different book each year.) Each kid that comes through the door gets one and it gives them something to focus on and have fun with during the service.

This year as families will be out in limited numbers (or not at all) I think this will be an even more meaningful way for Sunday School teachers to stay connected with their kids and help them engage with the Christmas story and the 12 days of Christmas - from home.

Follow the Star - Following Matthew 2 there is a scripture reading and activity for each of the 12 days of Christmas that familiarises kids with the wise men and their journey. There is a special activity at the end where kids can create their own wise men, follow the daily prompts and take their characters on a journey throughout their own house until they reach the Christ child on 12th night!
