

Personal Reflection & Growth Group Discussions
– Noah –
Genesis 6:9 – 7:12

(Choose the most appropriate questions below for discussion – you don't need to do them all :)

1. Discuss or consider how the Holy Spirit spoke to you through the passage or sermon.
2. Noah is called “righteous” (v 9) and is presented as an example of righteousness, along with Daniel & Job (Eze 14:12-19). Discuss what you know of the stories of each of these men. In what way does that shed light on what being “righteous” in conduct and character looks like? (Note: we are only made perfectly righteous in Christ)
3. Noah is described as being someone who “walked with God” (v 9, like Enoch, 5:22-24). It is the very essence of what God requires of us (Mic 6:8). Discuss what it means to walk with God.
[Hint: consider 2 Co 5:7, Gal 5:15-16, Eph 4:1, 5:8, 1 Jn 2:6, 3 Jn 1:3-4, etc]
4. Why do you think sin was so rampant (Gen 6:5, 11-12, 8:21)?
5. Do you consider the flood an act of grace or an act of anger?
6. If the consequences were that same no matter what we chose or what we did, we would be irrelevant. To have genuine freedom means that our choices and actions matter. How does this help us understand the character of God and some of the ways he deals with us?
7. What lessons do you take from Noah's story so far?
