

2 Samuel 6 – A Fool’s Worship

1. What insight, principle or observation from this week’s message did you find to be most helpful, eye opening or troubling? Please explain.
2. Have you ever thought about obedience as a part of worship before? In what ways might God be calling you to walk in obedience to him?
3. Praise and celebration are also ways that we worship God. Tell someone something that you are thankful for as praise to God.
4. We see in David’s life that he was wholly devoted to God and his worship was for God alone, not man. What are ways that we let the fear of man intrude on our worship of God? Whether that’s praise or obedience or whatever.
5. David’s worship may have seemed foolish to some, like his wife, Michal, but it was an acceptable offering to God. Read 1 Corinthians 1:27. What does that tell us about God’s kingdom and our worship in his kingdom?
6. Pray Together.

Challenge: Memorize 1 Corinthians 1:27 – “For God chose the foolish things in this world to shame the wise and the weak things to shame the strong.”
