I am so thankful to be back. I am settled into the same apartment I had before. My transitions have been interesting. Flying back under COVID restrictions was not easy but it was worth it. Two weeks in quarantine were very hard. I was able to walk in the early mornings when others were sleeping. I was able to get a lot of school work down, both for RFIS and TWU. (I am still working on my Masters degree). It was easier to interact with students while I was in the same time zone. One of the most stressful parts of quarantine was the isolation. Some people did come by to chat from a safe distance which helped. I felt especially isolated when I lost my internet connection for more than a day. I was so happy to get back to school on October 5. It was so good to be back on campus. After a week of school and madly writing report card comments we had a short break. After our break we returned to campus using a five day schedule with all students on campus every day. So far, we are healthy and enjoying almost normal interactions. One of the big highlights is our weekly chapels. I love watching the students learn to lead worship and hearing the stories of how God is at work as various staff members share their testimonies. I have the privilege of sharing on December 2. We have three weeks of classes left until Christmas break. After the break we will have one week of classes before the first semester final exams. I am excited to be part of planning the two day mini retreat which will start second semester in mid January.
